PARTICIPATION GUIDE

ACCOMODATION

We'll be staying at the University's student dorms. Each room is shared by two participants and is furnished with beds, desk, wardrobe and sink.

Extra nights at the dorms can be arranged, in case you arrive earlier or depart later. They have an extra cost for the participant and this service must be asked in advance until 10th June by email (ysm2015@ajc.pt)

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

TUTORS

It is not mandatory to have a supervisor attend the meeting with you. However, in the case of international participants, it is allowed one supervisor per group. In this situation, he/she must also fill the participation and travel forms.

Supervisors are welcome to attend the opening ceremony, projects presentation, lectures and farewell dinner and the Tourism day.

Workshops in labs and other activities of this nature are restricted to the participants. A few extra activities, such as travelling around the region, will be suggested for the supervisors. This costs will be covered by the supervisors themselves.

PREPARE YOUR PRESENTATION

All presentations will be held in an auditorium. You should prepare your presentation in PowerPoint or any similar format, and it should take about fifteen minutes (plus five extra for questions). No posters are required. All material should be in English (presentations in Portuguese are not allowed).

The order of the presentations will be known after the project selection. For any specific technical requirement please contact the organization by email.
